Peru Cafe Limited (also trading as Inca-Fe) meets the requirements of carboNZero^{Cert™} certification having measured its greenhouse gas emissions in compliance with the requirements of ISO 14064-1:2006, committed to managing and reducing its emissions and neutralised its remaining unavoidable emissions through the cancellation of an appropriate number of verified carbon credits in respect of the operational activities of its organisation.



Introduction¹ – Peru Café Limited (trading as Inca-Fe) is committed to process and sell only certified organic coffee. The company is fully BioGro certified. The company is also the only roaster certified to import FairTrade coffee. Peru Café Ltd started roasting in earnest through their 100% subsidiary Inca-Fe in New Plymouth early 2007. Inca-Fe operates as a family owned, large-capacity boutique coffee roaster using coffee sourced primarily from Peru, where the company has a large network of affiliates. The company's founders have a good understanding of coffee growing practices and an appreciation of the impact coffee growing can have on the often fragile ecosystems where it is cultivated. The company is determined to demonstrate that some of the best coffees are organic, that organic production in general is feasible on large scale; and that organic agriculture is truly sustainable in the long term. The company sees at the same time that organic farming, being a lot more labour intensive, could be an important source of employment in developing countries: employment in return for quality foods. The carboNZero certification is seen as an integral element of our commitment to organics and supporting their goals to achieve a truly sustainable business model. Our motto is where we have a choice to make things better at a little extra cost and/or effort, let's do it. We may get rewarded by our clients with more sales, or not, either way we can feel good about making the effort.

Boundary – The boundary for the preparation of the organisation's greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory is for one site. All business activities have been included.

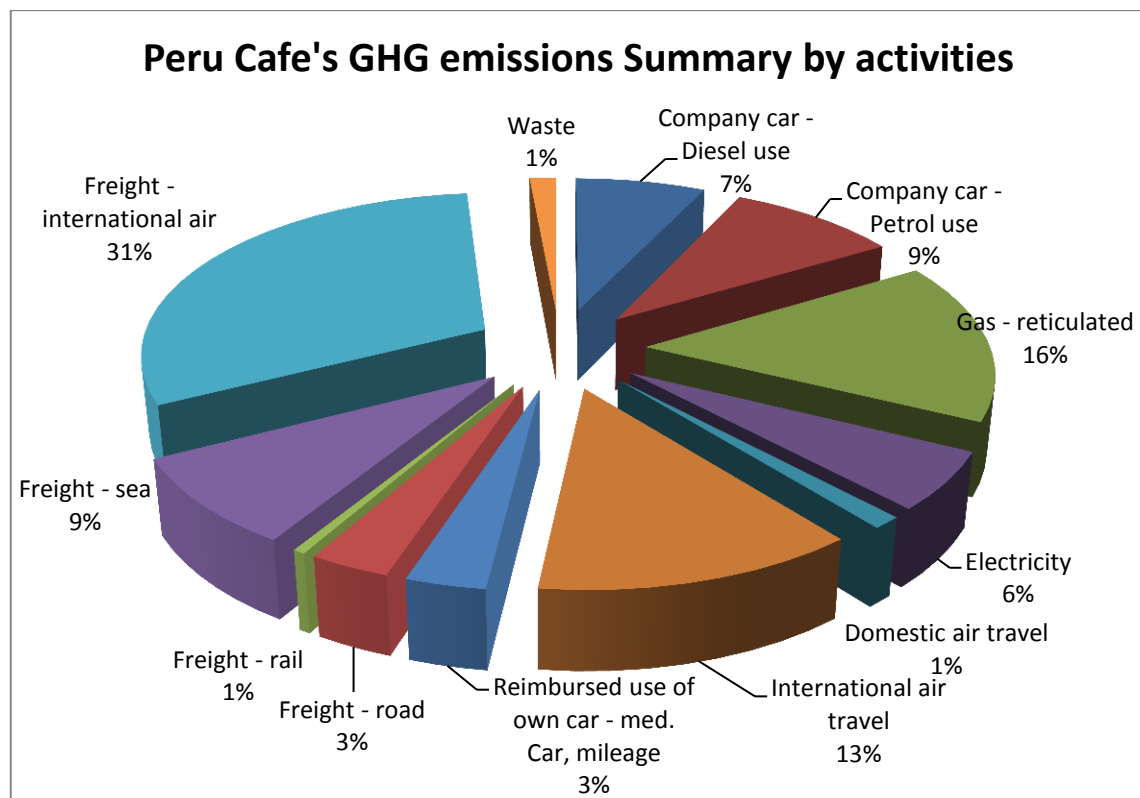

Emissions reduction commitments – Peru Cafe Limited has developed a GHG emissions reduction plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- Reduce air freight emissions by 30%
- Reduce International air travel by 10%
- Reduce Total inventory by 10%

Offset – 105 tCO₂e EBEX21 PFSI Compliance credits. Serial numbers 807356-807460 have been cancelled (or equivalent) on the New Zealand Emissions Unit Register.
